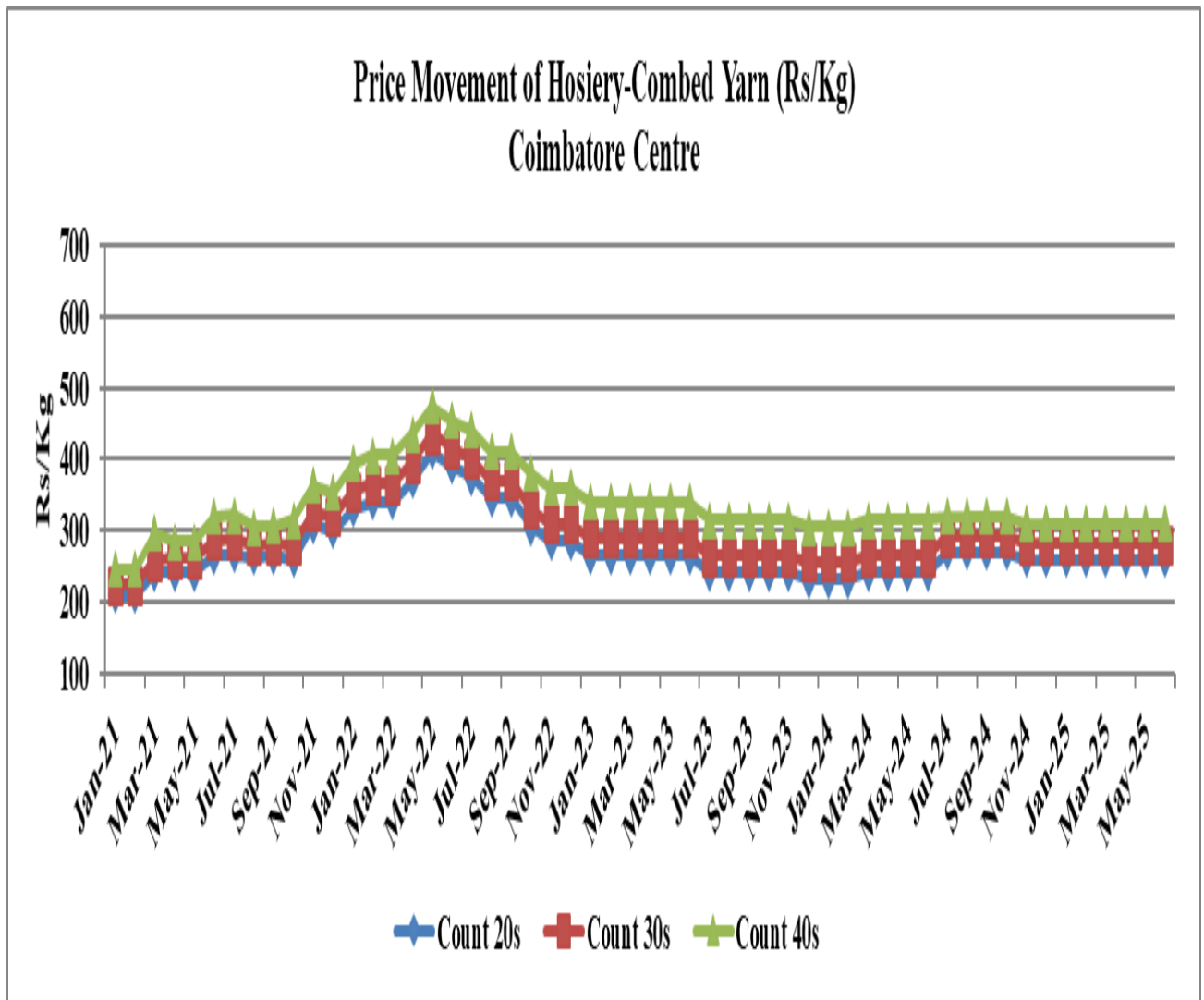

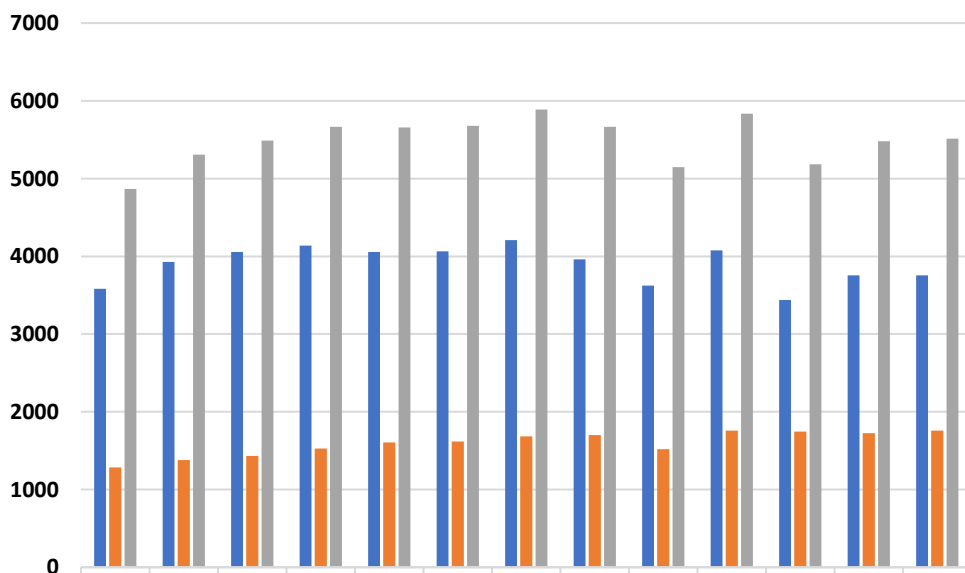

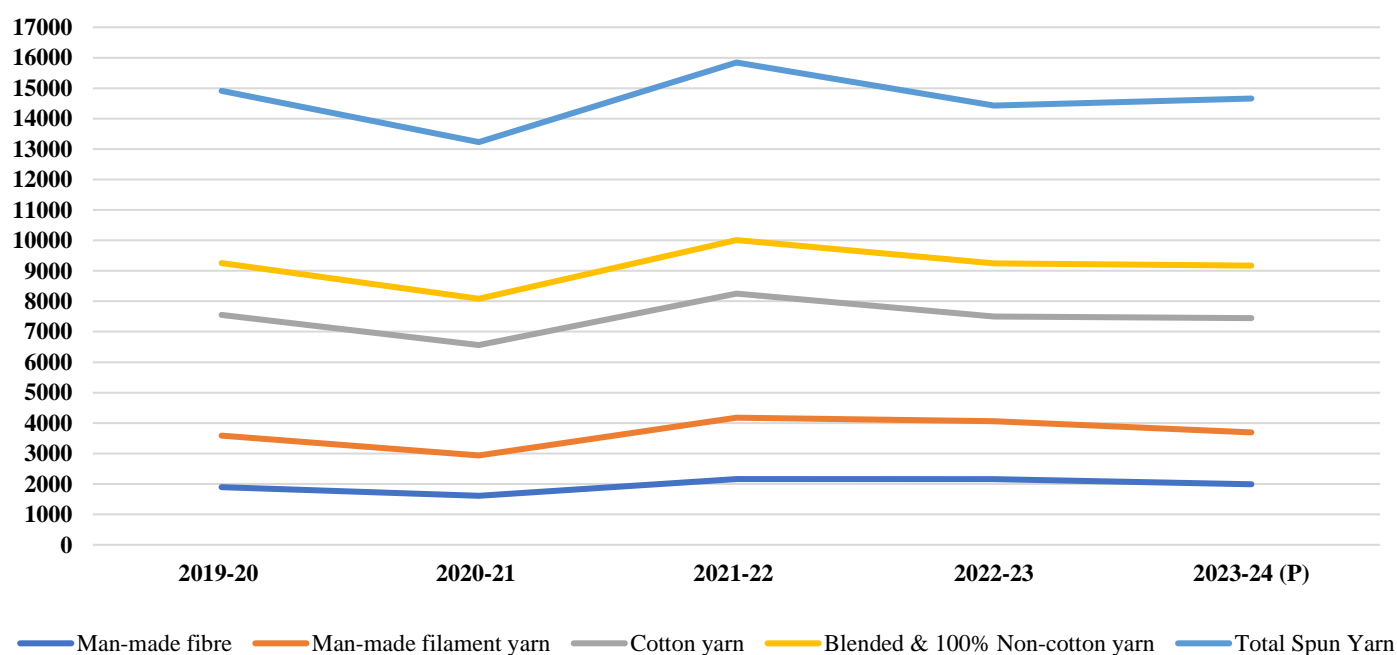

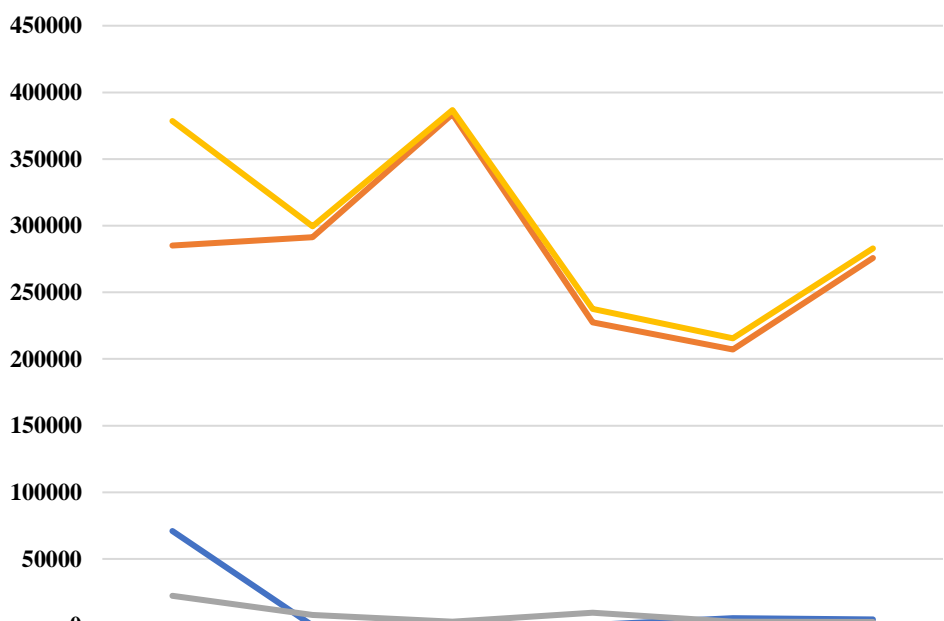

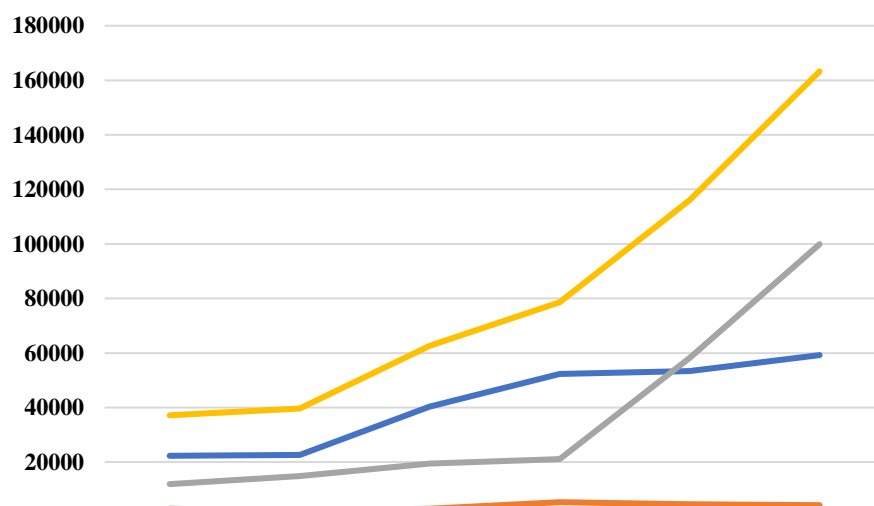

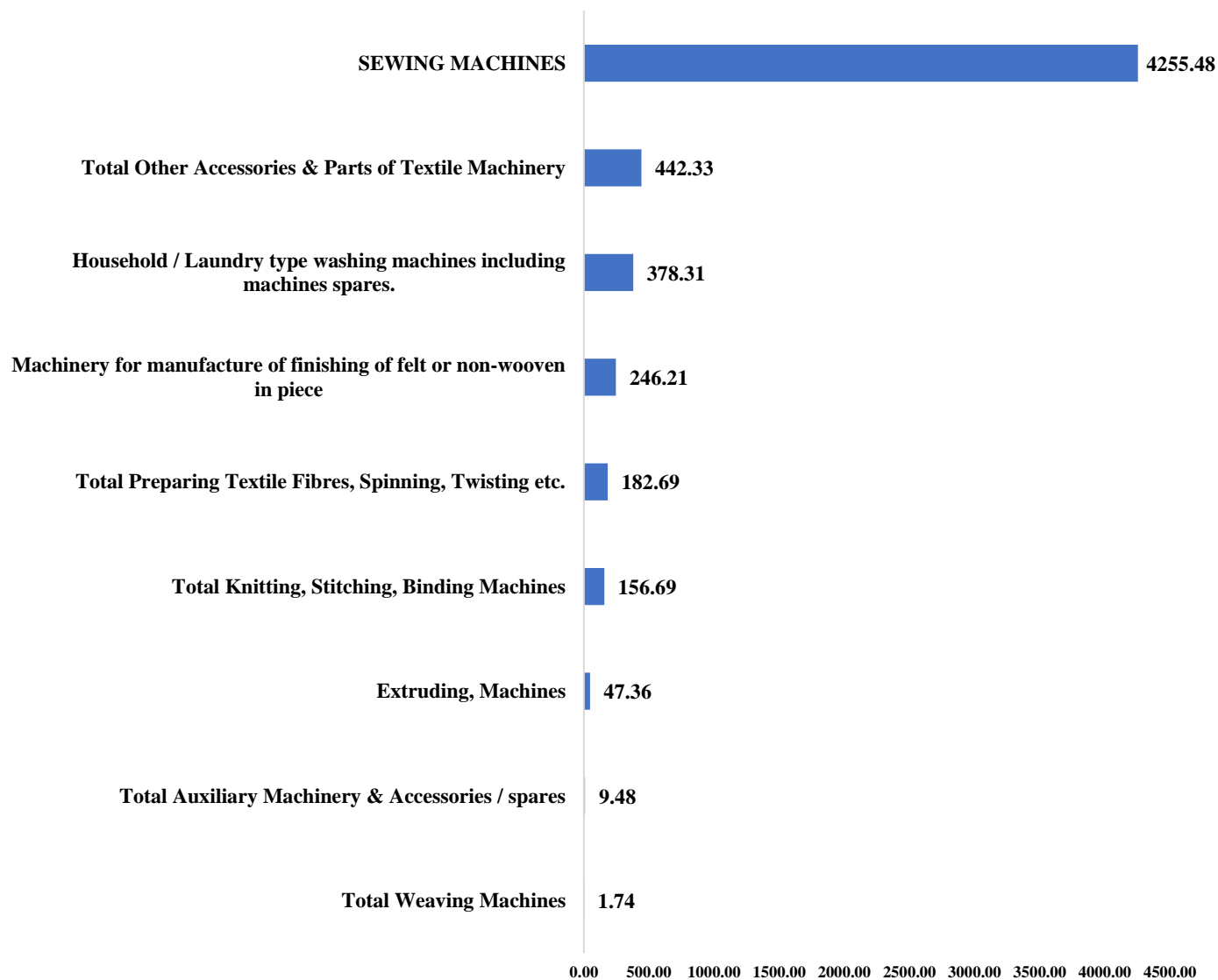

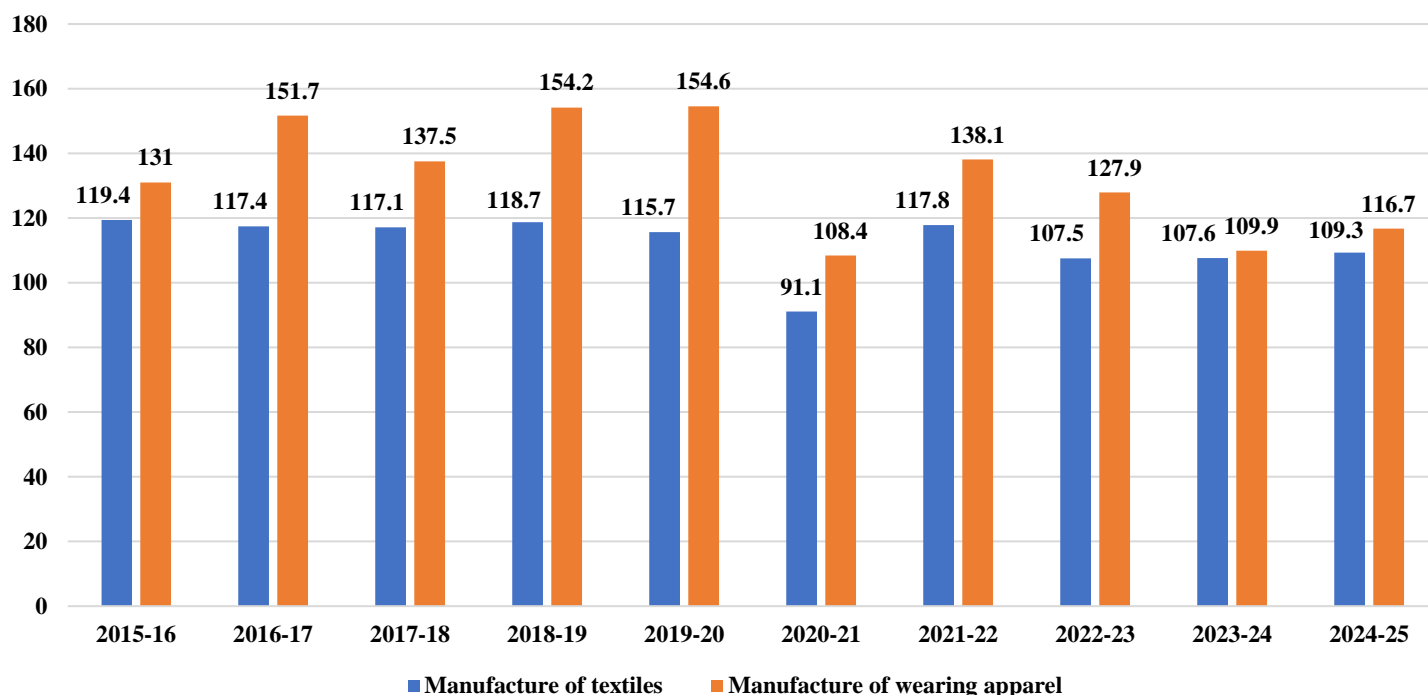

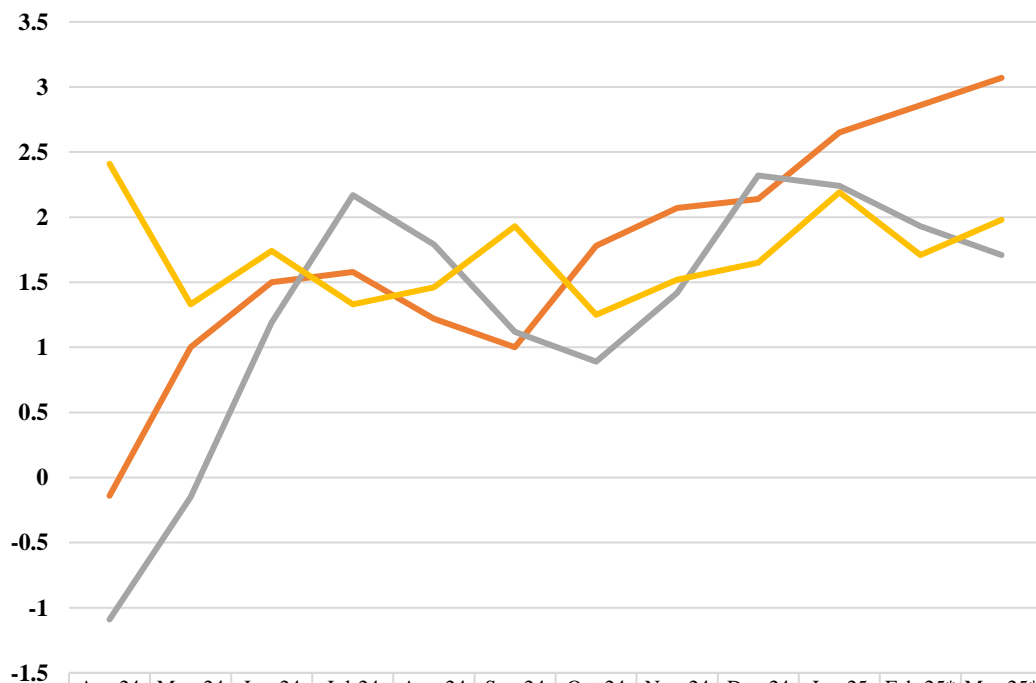

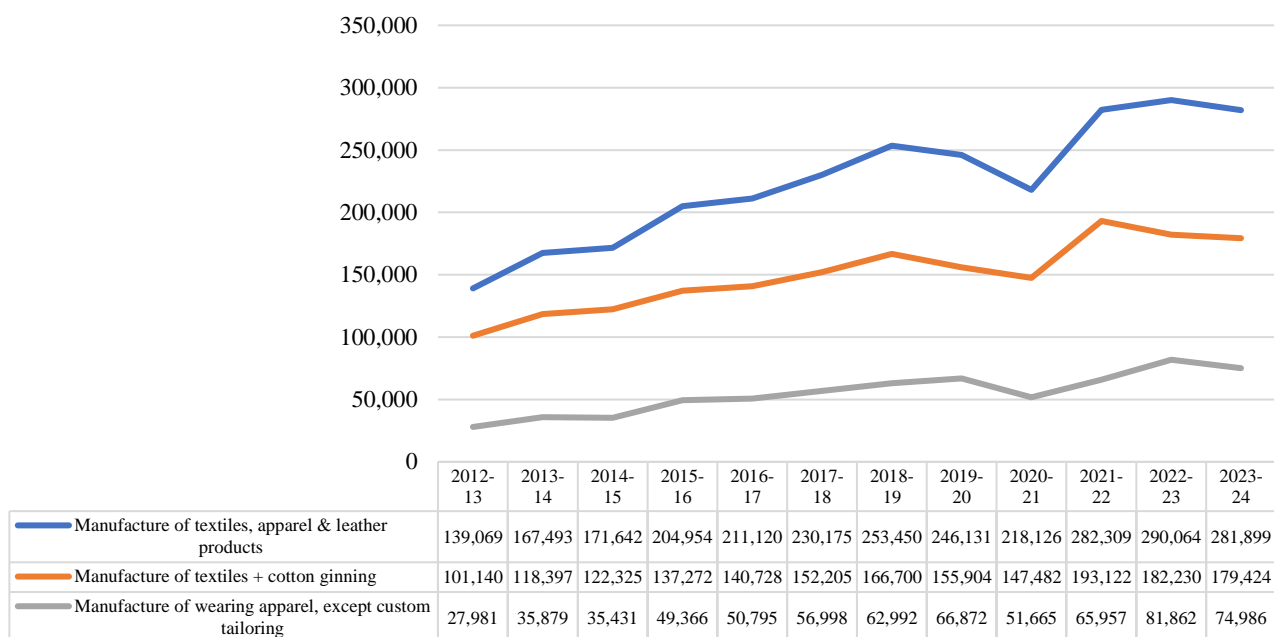

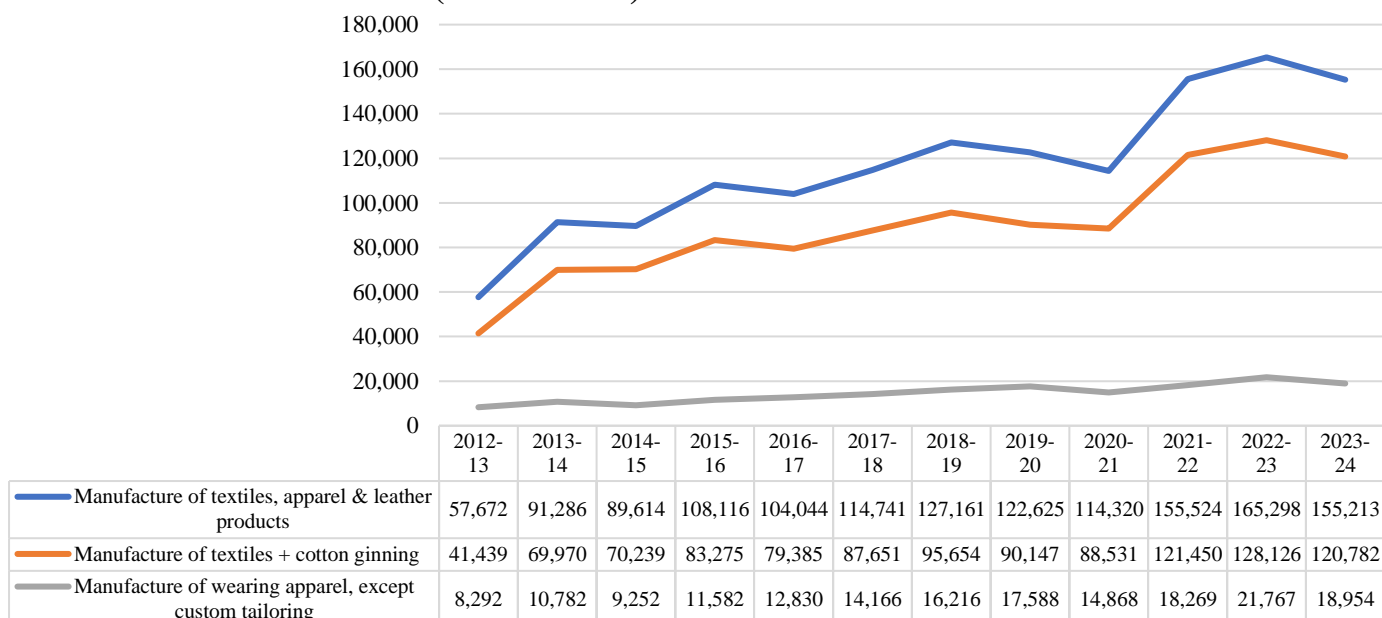

### India's share in Total World Export in Textile (In %)

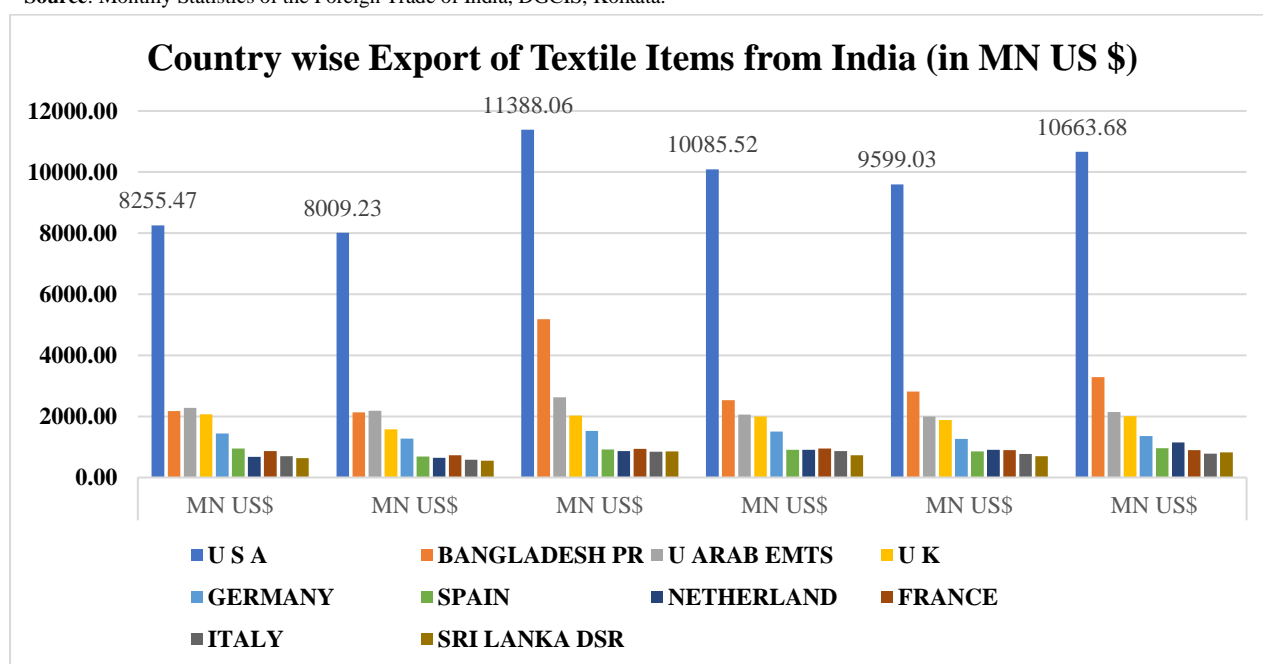

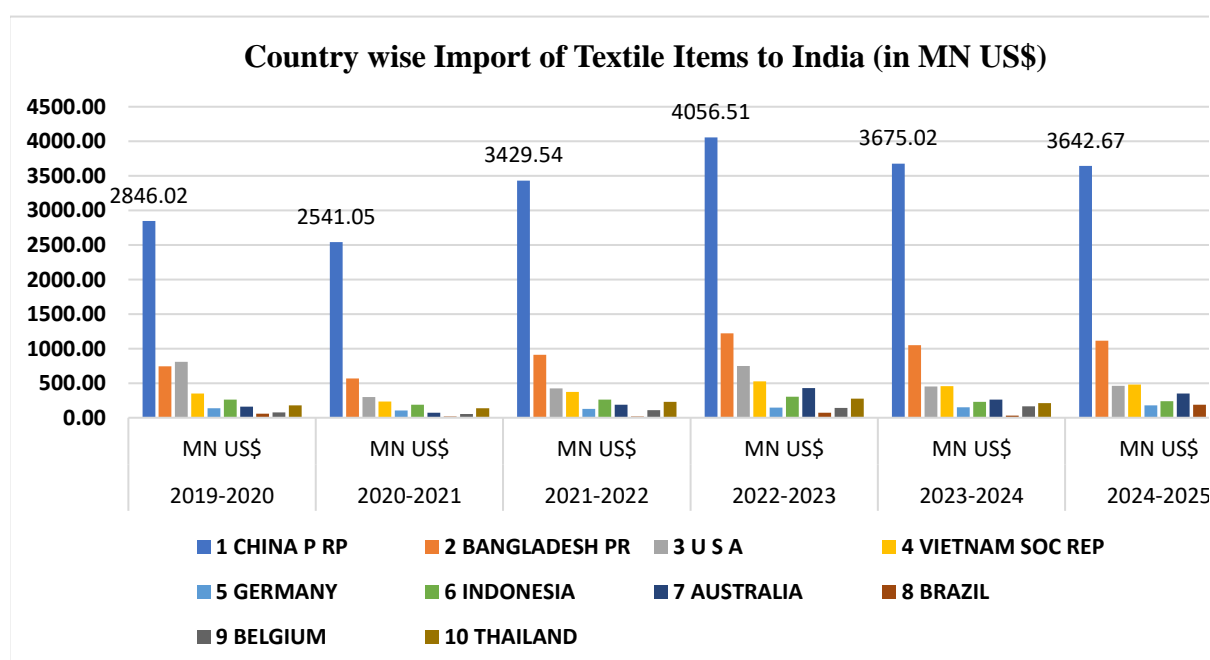

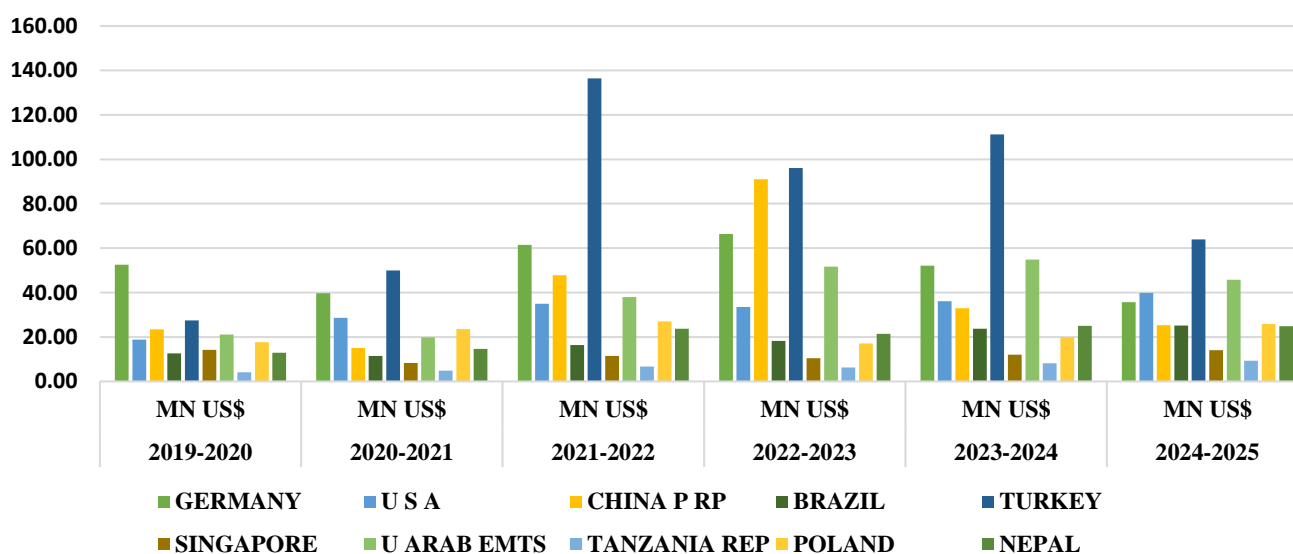

Country wise Export of Textile Machinery and Accessories etc (in MN US \$)

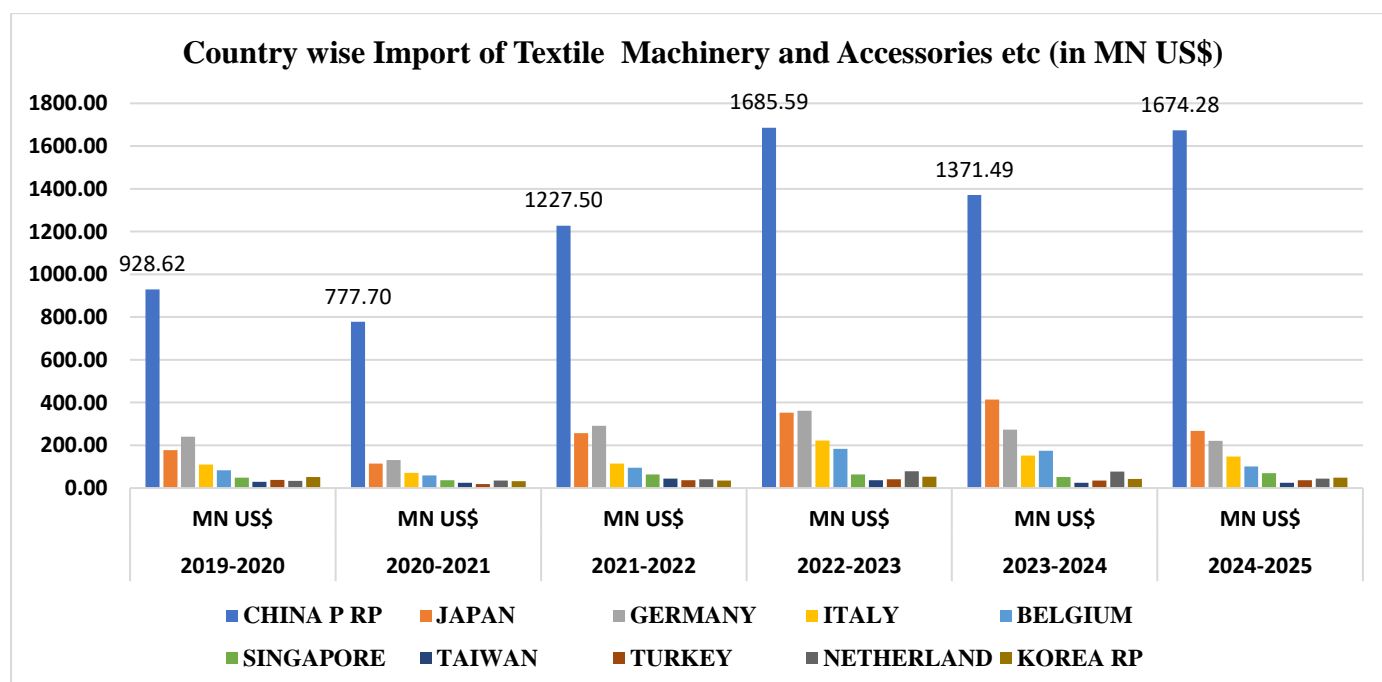

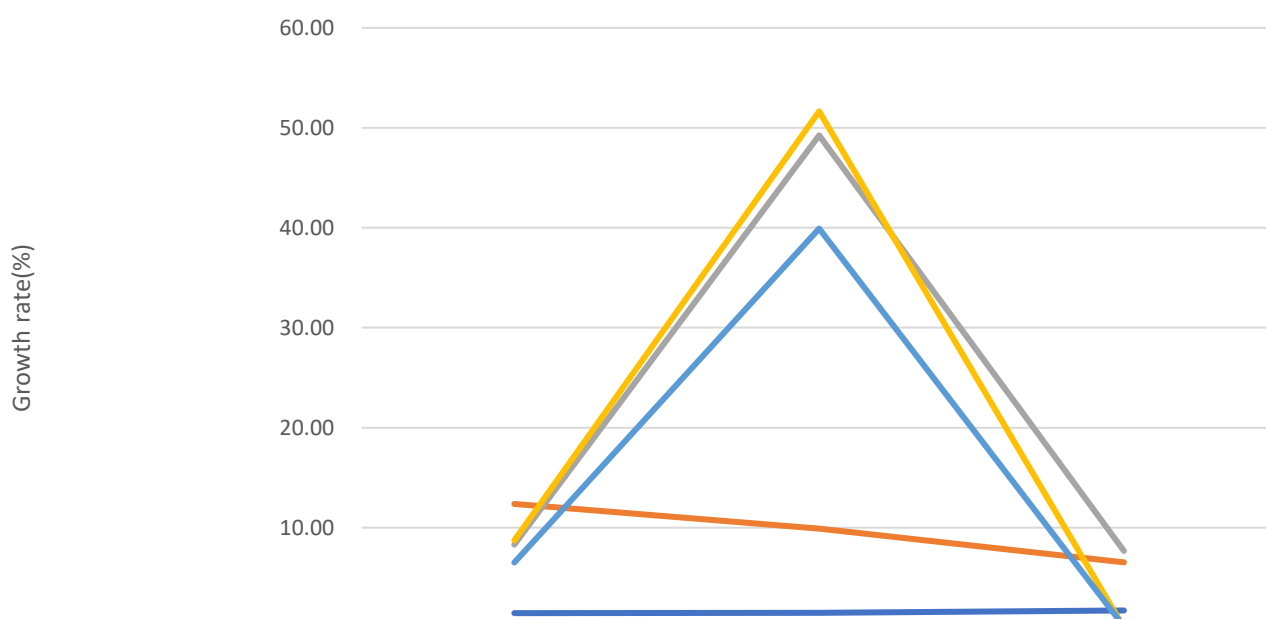

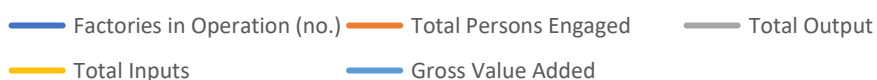

### Annual growth Rates (%) of Selected Characteristics for different years over previous year for Textile Sector -All India

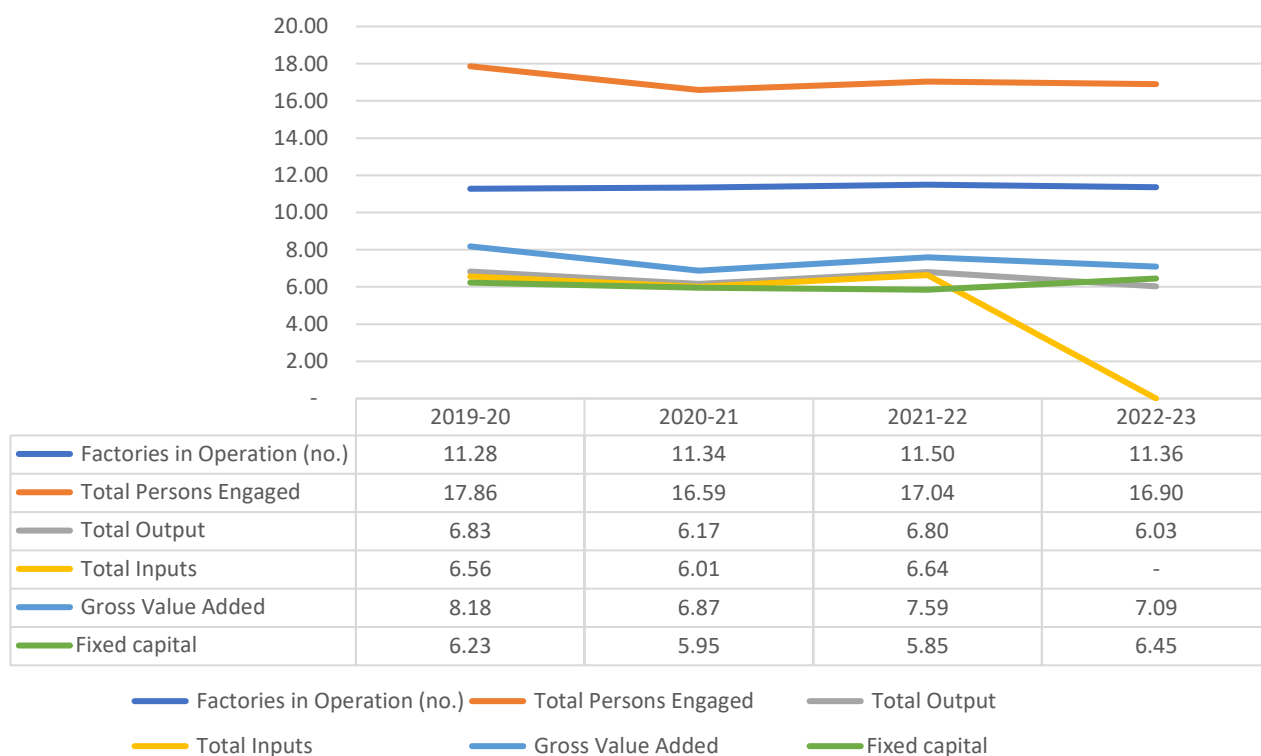
