**Minutes of the 29<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Internal Technical Committee under Amended  
Technology Up gradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS) held on 28.10.2021**

The 29<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Internal Technical Committee (ITC) under Amended Technology Up-gradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS) was convened on 28.10.2021 from 11.30 A.M. under the Chairmanship of Shri V.K. Kohli, Joint Textile Commissioner (T) in his cabin at the Office of the Textile Commissioner, Mumbai. The list of participants is attached as Annexure-I. The agenda points, which were discussed and decisions taken thereof are as under:-

**Agenda No.1: Verification and recommendation of 17 proposals for enlistment of Machinery Manufacturers/ Authorized Agents under ATUFS as per Para no. of 3.4 of Revised Resolution of ATUFS dated 02.08.2018 and subsequent order No. 6/5/2015-TUFS dated 06.08.2019**

**Decision Taken :** The list of 11 proposals (Abroad - 4, Indigenous – 7 ) received from Textile Machine Manufacturers/Authorized Agents for enlistment under ATUFS, were scrutinized by the Internal Technical Committee. Out of the said 11 proposals, 8 proposals (Abroad- 4 & Indigenous- 4) were recommended to the Textile Commissioner for her approval to upload the same on website of the Textile Commissioners Office (Attached herewith as Annexure-II). In respect of 3 (Three) indigenous unit, it was decided to verify their manufacturing capability through video conferencing / physical verification.

**Agenda Point No. 2: Cases forwarded by ATUFS Cell**

1. ATUFS cell have vide their note dt. 26/10/2021 forwarded a case wherein the Term Loan Sanction date is 15/7/2017 and the commercial invoice is raised by the authorised agent vide invoice dated 17/07/17, which is after the Term Loan sanction date. However, the machine is dispatched directly to the unit from the manufacturer vide Bill of lading dated 30/6/2017, which is prior to sanction of term loan and invoice date. As per the existing guidelines the purchase date means the commercial invoice date and machine purchased on or after the date of sanction of term loan only will be eligible under the scheme.

The OIC, RO Ahmadabad has also clarified that the order for the machinery was placed by the authorised agent to manufacturer, who then dispatched the machinery directly to the unit. The name of the unit and authorised agent appears in Bill of Lading and Certificate of Origin also.

**Decision Taken: The Committee felt that this matter is not under its purview and it may be taken up in the next TAMC meeting.**

2. TUFS Cell have vide note dt. 26/10/2021 forwarded the cases of M/s. Iconic Labels who has purchased machine claimed under MC-1-A1 i.e. Rapier Loom with wir 850 mtrs p.m. with Electronic Jacquard. In the name plate the machine is certified as a Label Weaving Machine. The concerned RO / Unit have submitted a letter from the manufacturer stating that the full description of the machine is "High Speed Automatic Shuttle less Rapier Label Weaving Loom with Weft Insertion Rate (WIR) 850 mtrs. per minute with Electronic Jacquard" and the word 'Label Weaving Machine' on the name plate of the machine is a common business practice. As per the remarks of the JIT, the unit is a Technical Textile Enterprise, manufacturing labels. However, they have claimed only 10% CIS. The matter is placed before the ITC for confirming the eligibility of the machine to consider subsidy under 10% CIS.

**Decision Taken: The committee has confirmed that eligibility of the machine under 10% CIS, of subsidy provided all other technical conditions have been met.**

3. TUFS Cell have vide note dt. 25/10/2021 forwarded the case of a unit which has claimed subsidy for PLC based Sueding Machine under ATUFS. The model number of Sueding Machine is mentioned as "Easy Supreme touch 6.2" in the invoice whereas model number is mentioned as "Easy Brush 6.2" in the machine name plate. Machine manufacturer has provided a certificate informing both models are same. TUFS section has requested to place the issue before ITC to take a suitable decision on the eligibility of the machine installed under ATUFS.

**Decision Taken: The ITC after due consideration felt that ATUFS Cell may consider the case for release of subsidy on fulfilment of all other criteria.**

### **Agenda Point No. 3**

TUFS Cell has vide Note dt. 12/10/21 forwarded an extract of the Minutes of the 23<sup>rd</sup> TAMC meeting held on 30/08/2021, with a request to place the same in the forthcoming ITC. In the 23<sup>rd</sup> TAMC the matter regarding price variation in the basic price of imported looms was discussed under Agenda Point No. 6 and the decision taken is reproduced below :-

"The matter was deliberated and decided that Internal Technical Committee (ITC) will work along with the Industry Associations and invitees & provide a segment-wise, machine-wise benchmark price range for machinery covered under ATUFS to enable processing of cases. The report on benchmarked price range may be placed before the upcoming TAMC for discussion and decision.

As such it was suggested by Industry members that over invoicing by some vitiate the whole process. Mechanism for blacklisting of such cases may be developed. Manufacturer/ supplier / units who have submitted the above over invoice may be considered to be declared as defaulter for claims submitted in the next two years from the Government of India Schemes”.

**Decision Taken:** After a long deliberation, it was decided that TUFs Cell may be asked to provide the details for taking further necessary action in the matter. It was also decided that the concerned Industry Associations may also be approached to get the segment-wise, machine-wise benchmark average price range of Chinese and European textile machinery covered under ATUFS.

**Agenda Point No. 4**

A representation has been received from the All India Man-Made Metallic Yarn Association dt. 14/10/2021 for withdrawal of restriction of Handloom Sector for machines covered at Sr. No. 12,13,14,15 & 16 in MC-5 of GR on Amended TUFs. The Association has informed that the said machines i.e. Coating Machine for Metallic Yarn, Universal Double Covering Machine for Jari Processing only, Micro Slitting machine for Jari Processing only, Coating Vacuum Metalizer for Jari Processing only and Twisting Doubling machine for Jari Processing only, have been installed by Surat based Jari Processing Units and due to the restriction of their being eligible for Handloom Sector only, these units are deprived of the benefits of ATUFS.

The Association has also informed that the said machines have no direct or immediate next chain connection in Handloom and that Handloom segment will not be capable to invest such a huge amount to purchase these machines. The use of such machines is not feasible under the Handloom Sector and the data of National Handloom of the past two decades will reflect that none of the above said machines were installed in the Handloom Sector

**Decision Taken:** As articles of clothing with zari has been reserved for exclusive production by Handloom, vide The Handlooms (Reservation of Articles for Production) Act, 1985 , this issue may not be in the purview of ITC. As such the matter may be taken up with the Development Commissioner Handlooms, Ministry of Textiles, New Delhi.
