

**Minutes of the 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Internal Technical Committee under Amended Technology  
Up gradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS) be held on 15-09-2020**

The 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Internal Technical Committee constituted by the Textile Commissioner for examining the proposals for enlistment of textile machinery manufactures under Amended Technology Up gradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS) was held on 15-09-2020 at 11.00 AM under the Chairmanship of Shri S.P.Verma, Joint Textile Commissioner in the conference hall of the Office of the Textile Commissioner, Mumbai. The list of participants is attached as *Annexure-I*.

The agenda points which were discussed and decisions taken thereof are as under:-

**Agenda No. 1: Confirmation of the minutes of 8<sup>th</sup> Internal Technical Committee Meeting.**

**Decision Taken:** The Committee confirmed the minutes of the 8<sup>th</sup> Internal Technical Committee Meeting unanimously.

**Agenda No. 2: Verification and recommendation of 17 proposals for enlistment of Machinery Manufacturers/ Authorized Agents under ATUFS as per Para no. of 3.4 of Revised Resolution of ATUFS dated 02.08.2018 and subsequent order No. 6/5/2015-TUFS dated 06.08.2019.**

**Decision Taken :** The list of 17 proposals (Abroad - 5, Indigenous - 6 & Authorized agents - 6) received from Textile Machine Manufacturers/Authorized Agents for enlistment under ATUFS, were scrutinized by the Internal Technical Committee and 11 proposals (Abroad- 4 & Indigenous- 3 and Authorized Agent - 4) were recommended to the Textile Commissioner for her approval and for uploading the same on this office website (Attached herewith as *Annexure-II*). It was also decided to carry out physical verification in the case of three indigenous units and in case of one unit located abroad was recommended subject to receipt of original undertaking which is still awaited. The request received from two Authorized Agents was not considered as the parent manufacturing company is already having another Authorized Agent registered under ATUFS Scheme. The Committee was of the opinion that country-wise only one authorized agent should be permitted. It was also suggested by the Committee that authorized agents for those machine manufactures only have to be permitted, who are not selling their machine directly to anybody like Toyota (Japan) for safeguard of

government subsidy by claiming more subsidy as authorized agents are raising the invoices for machines under ATUFS.

**Agenda No. 3: Request of Tiruppur Export Knit Printers Association:**

The Tiruppur Export Knit Printers Association have requested for the inclusion of 'Computerized Multi Head printing machine for garment and garment panels under MC -02. At present the said machine is appearing under MC-04 i.e Machinery for Apparel and Garment. Now, the association want it to cover under MC-02 i.e. Machinery for processing of yarn/fibre/fabric so that all printing units doing job work of printing on knitted garments can avail the benefit of the scheme.

**Decision Taken :** After Due deliberation, the committee felt that the 'Computerized Multi head printing machine for garment and garment panels' may be covered under MC-02 also i.e. Machinery for Processing of Fibre/Yarn/Fabric.

**Agenda No. 4: Request of M/s. G. M. Fabrics Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai**

M/s. G. M. Fabrics Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai have requested to incorporate plant for Ammonia treatment through air tight Jigger under ATUFS. It involves processing of Textile Fabrics in anhydrous liquid ammonia treatment through air tight Jigger which is by loading the fabrics on the Jigger which is passed through anhydrous liquid ammonia treatment and there after the fabrics which is cellulose / cotton fibre undergoes chemical changes and converts into Cellulose III.

For textile use the fabrics becomes very soft like pure silk which is a value addition to the cotton fabric. The treated fabric is also free of wrinkles and does not need ironing which is desirable.

**Decision Taken:** The Committee observed that 'PLC controlled Ammonia mercerizing machine for fabrics is already covered under MC-2 (i.e. Machinery for processing of Fibre/Yarn/Fabric) at Sr.No. 14 and as such there is no need to allow standalone ammonia treatment plant under ATUFS.

**Agenda No. 5: Consideration of Label weaving machine supplied by MEI International S.R.L, Italy:-**

13<sup>th</sup> TAMC in its meeting held on 23.02.2019 deliberated that Basic loom with label jacquard machine procured from same manufacture only will be allowed under ATUFS. However, if woven label manufacturing attachment is required to be provided on standalone basis, it may be

considered separately by TAMC on receipt of request from industry / machine manufacturer. In this regard, M/s. MEI International S.R.L, Italy has submitted a request to consider their machine stating that *"no machine manufacturers are manufacturing all the auxiliary machines, accessories and components in-house. In case of Airjet looms and rapier looms produced by loom manufacturers, the jacquard, Harness, Accumulators etc., are bought-out items produced by other manufacturers. MEI is buying Airjet / Rapier looms from machinery manufacturer as per the choice of customers, modifying looms suitable for label weaving attaching MEI technology developed by them and readying it for weaving labels. The Airjet looms and Rapier looms are already under ATUFS and are eligible for subsidy"*.

Decision Taken in the 4<sup>th</sup> ITC meeting held on 1/1/2020: The Committee is of the view of taking Label manufacturing attachment as a separate or it can be considered as accessories of the weaving machine for manufacture of Labels. The matter may be referred to the TAMC for deliberation and decision.

Decision Taken in the 15<sup>th</sup> TAMC meeting held on 2/1/2020 : The matter was deferred to the next TAMC. Meanwhile ITC may send a team to examine the technology and recommending whether it is to be considered as main machine or accessory

Decision Taken in the 7<sup>th</sup> ITC meeting held on 7/7/2020 : The Officer-in-Charge, R.O. Coimbatore and SITRA representative may visit the unit and submit the report within 15 days to ITC for further consideration of the matter. If visiting team requires any help, they may contact either Jt.Tx.C's. Shri S.P.Verma / Shri V.K.Kohli through Video Conference

Accordingly. R.O.Coimbatore have visited the unit and submitted the visit report with the following conclusion:

"It is observed that MEI International srl Rapier and Airjet Label loom provides good quality performance, production efficiency and innovative technology. The speed of Air Jet label machine is up to 1050 picks / min and speed of Rapier machine is 650 pick / min (WIR is 1040 mtrs per minute)

Therefore, the visiting team is of the opinion that the MEI Label Weaving machines can be considered as the main machines.

Decision Taken: Due to paucity of time, the matter was deferred to the next ITC meeting.

**Agenda No. 6 : Request of South Gujarat Warp Knitters Association :**

The South Gujarat Warp Knitters Association has requested for the inclusion of high speed multibar Rachel Knitting machines / High performance Jacquard Rachel machines / fully fashion high speed knitting machines. These machines are versatile in nature and can produce garments like shrug / unstics kurti as well as Designer Fabric. These machines are of the latest technology in the

world of Rachel machines and can produce garment article directly on the machine without any stitching.

**Decision Taken:** Due to paucity of time, the matter was deferred to the next ITC meeting.

**Agenda No. 7: Agenda points received from R.O.Noida**

- a. **Issue of M/s. Twenty First Century Creation Pvt. Ltd. :** The unit purchased one soft flow dyeing machine from M/s. Krsna Engimech Pvt. Ltd., Ahmadabad. As per the photographs submitted by the unit, only Model name / Brand name i.e. "KEMPL" appears on the machine plate and not the manufacturers' full name. As per para 6.4.2 of GR, make, month/year of manufacture, name of the manufacturer and serial number of all eligible benchmarked machinery are to be clearly indicated on the machine(s). Further, as per the decision taken in the 15<sup>th</sup> TAMC meeting, the ITC may take a view on case to case basis for such type of cases.
- b. **Issue of M/s. Nikhil Blanket Inc., Panipat. :** The unit purchased 6 nos. of knitting machines from M/s. Xiamen Qiaoxing Zhenfu Import & Export Co., Ltd., China and provided an authorization certificate stating that M/s. Xiamen Qiaoxing Zhenfu Import and Export Co. Ltd., which is the legally designated unit to sell the product of M/s. Zhenfu Knitting Machine Co. Ltd. However, only Brand name i.e. PAILEX appears on the machine plate and not the manufacturer's name.

**Decision Taken:** The Committee noted that as per the GR dt. 13/01/2016, the applicant should ensure that the make, month/year of manufacture, name of the manufacturer and serial number of all the eligible benchmarked machinery are clearly indicated on the machine. It was also noted in both the above instances, the manufacturer has not submitted a note detailing their branding exercise, marketing practices and shared their authentic logo, as decided in the 15<sup>th</sup> TAMC meeting.

According, the Committee unanimously decided that both the above cases may not be eligible to claim for subsidy under ATUFS.

**Agenda No. 8: Agenda point received from R.O , Guntur.**

This issue pertains to M/s. Madhav Textiles. Surat : The unit purchased Water Jet Loom from M/s. Qingdao Jinsanyang Textile Machinery Technology Co., Ltd., China. As per the photographs submitted at the time of JIT, the manufacturers name is not seen on the machine name plate. However, based on the clarification asked by TUFS Cell Mumbai, R.O. Ahmadabad has

resubmitted the photographs of machine name plate vide their letter dt. 29/3/2019. In the revised photographs the name of the manufacturer can be seen on the machine name plate. The OIC of Ahmadabad has confirmed that the machine supplier has provided new number plates of machine including the name of the company with no other variations except the company name.

**Decision Taken:** The Committee decided that such fraudulent practice of changing the machine name plate after JIT should not be allowed / considered.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
