

SEC 4. (1) (b) (viii) A STATEMENT OF THE BOARDS, COUNCILS, COMMITTEES AND OTHER BODIES CONSISTING OF TWO OR MORE PERSONS CONSTITUTED AS ITS PART OR FOR THE PURPOSE OF ITS ADVISE, AND AS TO WHETHER MEETINGS OF THOSE BOARDS, COUNCILS, COMMITTEES AND OTHER BODIES ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, OR THE MINUTES OF SUCH MEETINGS ARE ACCESSIBLE FOR PUBLIC

1. Ministry of Textiles, Government of India vide its letter No.11/31/2020-Fibre-I dated 14.09.2020 has formulated a Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption (COCP) for estimation of various data on cotton including production, supply, demand, export and closing stock of cotton etc. every year to help planning strategy for development of the Cotton Sector.
2. Ministry of Textiles, Government of India vide its O.M.No.11/18/2022-Fibre-I dated 25.05.2022 has constituted Textile Advisory Group (TAG) for Cotton, an informal group of deliberate and recommend on issues pertaining to the entire cotton value chain.
3. Hank Yarn Price Monitoring Committee : The committee under the chairmanship of Tx.C. to take stock of the availability and price of hank yarn, the major raw material for the handloom sector.
4. Rajbasha(Hindi) Implementation Committee : For the progressive implementation of the Rajbasha (Hindi) office, such committees are formed at each office level, location and area level and state level.
5. Powerloom Programme Cluster Implementation and Coordination Committee (PPCICC) : At the ITADC level, normally under the chairmanship district collector or such a senior officer of the State Govt., to over see the overall development of powerloom cluster.
6. TAMC Technical Advisory cum Monitoring Committee . The committee meets whenever necessity is there.

The committees and boards mentioned above are meant for the overall development of the various sectors of the Textile Industry and the decisions taken in these committees and boards are for the development of the Industry and are percolated to the various areas of the industry for the effective utilization of policies for overall development. Over and above, officers of this office as well as Regional Offices & Integrated Textile & Apparel Development Center (ITADC) are members of various committees formed by other agencies especially in the textile field in their region.
